

## **AUTHOR INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS**

The 9USN/10CCEE poster sessions have been carefully organized to group similar presenters together to create coherent sessions on specific topics. The printed program will list complete titles and authors of all papers in poster sessions, and they will also be listed on signs near the poster stations. We anticipate these being lively sessions in which to present your paper in a formal yet more personal setting.

**Position:** The printed program will list the position for every poster by poster board number. Be sure to use the board assigned to you.

**Size:** The poster boards will be one 4' x 8' (1.25m x 2.5m) side of a self-standing poster board, with a horizontal layout. The board will be push-pin compatible; a supply of push pins will be available. The most successful posters have an uncluttered layout and large graphics. **Time:** We request that your poster be set up in the morning of the day it is assigned, before the beginning of all sessions. It should remain posted all day. For information on the assigned date for your poster, please visit <http://submissions.miracd.com/2010eqconf/Itinerary/>.

You will notice that the schedule indicates a one-hour time slot during the afternoon of the specified date. That is the time you are requested to be present at your poster to discuss it with attendees. There are no conflicts with other sessions, as this hour is allocated entirely to the poster session, so it will be well attended.

Please take your poster down by 6:00 p.m. Posters not removed by authors may be removed by staff, who will make an effort to store them for retrieval at a later time during the conference, but no guarantees can be made.
